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Scheme Architecture - Overview



PUBLIC MONEY FOR PUBLIC GOODS

While this recycles money from the Basic Payments Scheme It is different

- Three main 'schemes'
 - Sustainable Farming Incentive (SFI)
 - Local Nature Recovery (LNR)
 - Landscape Recovery (LR)
- One of which (Landscape Recovery) is brand new
- Plus a range financially smaller supporting 'schemes'

Sustainable Farming Incentive



- Intended to be widely available
- Delivered via a series of tiered standards (introductory, intermediate, advanced) covering subjects such as soil health and animal welfare
- Pays for regulation +
- On line application
- Capable of being 'stacked' with Local Nature Recovery and / or private sector finance
- Possibly 30% of the available budget

Local Nature Recovery



- Broadly replaces Countryside Stewardship / Higher Level Scheme
- Prescriptions and payments for creating and managing wildlife rich habitats
- Possibly a share (with Landscape Recovery) of 60% of the available budget

Landscape Recovery



- Brand new!
- Paying for major land use change
- Looking for landscape scale partnership working
- Government contract will be with the partnership (not the individual)
- No prescriptions or set payments – the partnership negotiates a delivery contract with government
- Twenty + year agreement
- Not stackable with SFI / LNR but government looking for ‘blended finance’ (private sector contribution)
- Possibly a share (with Local Nature Recovery) of 60% of the budget

Supporting Schemes

Some of which are transitional / temporary



- Farming in Protected Landscapes (AONBs & NPs)
- Farming Investment Fund
- Farming Equipment & Technology Fund
- Farming Transformation Fund
- Slurry Investment Scheme
- New Entrants Scheme
- Future Farm Resilience Fund
- Skills & Training
- Animal Welfare
- Altogether possibly 10% of the available budget
