- Purchase of land in 1998 beginning of a learning journey.
- Over grazing and lack of hedges.
- No hares, hedgehogs or yellowhammers.
- Absence of insects.
- Extensive use of chemicals fertilizer, pesticides, herbicides and insecticides.
- Rivers, streams and land all polluted.
- Focus on 'tidiness' and industrial farming for the production of cheap food.







Hollis Mead organic dairy – a solution in the making...

- Farming 'differently'...
- Control what happens to the land.
- Extensive grazing outside most of the year.
- Plant hedges, trees, create 'rough' areas.
- NO CHEMICALS.
- No contract with processors they are the enemy of nature.
- Pasture fed only cattle.
- Low yield high value. Low impact.
- Create network of vending machines.



Hollis Mead organic dairy – a solution in the making...

- Create a brand.
- Build distribution (River Cottage, Pipers Farm, etc.)
- Build online presence.
- Create 'noise' with market presence.
- Invest in good PR.
- Reuse everything 'circular economy'.
- Create understanding of why 'slow food' is important
- Hire local people.
- Encourage local procurement hospitals, prisons, schools and local authorities – why import?
- Spread the message.
- · Bring other farmers on board.
- Expand the footprint of nature.







What have we achieved?

- Great products which are becoming better known.
- Low yielding but longer living cows.
- Good prices for products and calves so not impossible.
- Direct to the consumer model.
- 20 kms of hedges planted.
- Much cleaner water in the River Hooke.
- Much greater sub soil life.
- Amazing insect life.
- Wildflowers coming back.
- Regular biodiversity studies by Dorset Wildlife Trust.
- Good brown hare and dormice population.
- Employment for 12 people.
- A lovely untidy farm...
