
DEFRA's Landscape Recovery Scheme

- Sustainable Farming Incentives (SFI), Local Nature Recovery (LNR)/ Countryside Stewardship (CS), Landscape Recovery (LR)
- Landscape Recovery is for ambitious projects that bring farmers and landowners together across 500Ha+
- Wareham Arc is a Round 1 LR project

Increased connection between habitats, people and nature, and landowners and land managers


Nature for all - more diverse audiences learning about nature and accessing wild spaces



Expected outcomes - environmental



- River corridors naturalised and wetlands created
- Mires rewetted and restored
- Farmland and forestry extensification
- Heathland restoration
- Reduction in net CO2e emissions
- Improvement in water quality
- Reduced impact from invasive species
- Increase in habitat connectivity
- Increase in species abundance and biodiversity

Expected outcomes - social




- More, and more diverse, people engaging in nature-based activities
